

Restore Cleanser & Moisturizer

Protocol

This protocol is intended to supplement, not replace, your facility's guidelines and/or common practices.

Desired Outcomes

- Cleanse, moisturize and protect healthy skin at risk for breakdown
- Cleanse, moisturize and protect compromised skin

Equipment

1. Restore Cleanser & Moisturizer Skin Protectant
2. Soft Cloth
3. Gloves

Procedures

- Application of product
- Documentation of observations

Application of Product

1. Assemble supplies and take to bedside.
2. Identify and inform patient of procedure.
3. Provide for privacy.
4. Apply gloves.
5. Position patient so that the affected area is exposed.
6. Adjust trigger spray nozzle on Restore Cleanser & Moisturizer Skin Protectant to create a direct stream or mist and spray affected area. Gently wipe off with soft cloth to remove any debris (*no rinsing is required*).
7. Apply Restore Cleanser & Moisturizer Skin Protectant again to the entire affected area (*Cleanser & Moisturizer Skin Protectant provides a transparent, non-occlusive barrier*).
8. Remove gloves and wash hands after completing procedure.

Documentation of Observations

Document procedure and other pertinent observations regarding the condition of the skin.

Guidelines for Maintaining Healthy Skin*

- Inspect skin at least once a day.
- Individualize bathing schedule. Avoid hot water. Use mild cleansing agent.
- Minimize environmental factors. Use moisturizer for dry skin.
- Avoid massage over bony prominences.
- Cleanse skin at time of soiling and at routine intervals
- Minimize skin injury due to friction and shear forces through proper positioning, transferring and turning techniques.
- Use lubricants, protective film dressings and padding to reduce the chance of damage.
- Make sure proper nutrition is maintained and the dietary intake of protein is sufficient. Additional supplements may be required.
- Monitor and document interventions and outcomes.

Denude	Loss of epidermis
Erythema	Redness of the skin surface
Excoriation	Linear scratches on the skin
Induration	Abnormal firmness of tissue with a definite margin
Maceration	Softening of tissue by soaking in fluids
