Sue Lennon is currently a Psychosexual Therapist working with those suffering the sexual consequences of a life changing illness or injury.

Experience

During Sue's 28-year nursing career, she recognized that assessing and addressing the sexual side effects of illness, injury and treatment is often a missing piece in the holistic care 'jigsaw'.

Therefore, she set out to challenge her own practice, enabling those difficult conversations to happen and to help her patients find the help they needed to reconstruct their sex life.

In 2007, Sue began training as a sex therapist and started a rehab clinic within the oncology service where she worked. However, soon after beginning this service she began receiving referrals from many other departments whose patients had nowhere else to go.

Sue left nursing and the UK in 2016 and now lives in France where she runs an online sex therapy service helping people from across the globe. Sue's clients are mainly (but not exclusively) those with SCI or IBD/Ostomy or continence problems, and of course, cancer.

Sue speaks at international health care conferences and links with multiple charities and associations in a bid to raise awareness and to encourage equitable access for all.
